This year marks 118 year of the establishment of the town of Allensworth, California which is now a California State Historic Park. This is also the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Colonel Allensworth State Historic Park becoming a California State Park. The Department will mark this anniversary through our special event programs, one of which is the "Annual Town Rededication" which will be held October 10, 2026. Several thousand people are expected to attend. One of the opening day activities at this event will be the "Colonel Allensworth 5k Run Walk for Health." For the 18<sup>th</sup> year, the 5k Run Walk for Health will take place in the park.

As you are aware, addressing health issues is one of the highest priorities facing California and the country at large. This event will bring focus to this very important Issue. In August of 1908, Colonel Allen Allensworth and four of other settlers established a town founded, financed and governed by African Americans. In 1974 California State Parks purchased land within the historical town site of Allensworth and it became Colonel Allensworth State Historic Park. Today, a collection of lovingly restored and reconstructed early 20th century buildings once again dots this flat farm country giving new life to the dreams of these visionary pioneers.
